<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Poison Ivy Bull Nettle Fire Ants Wasps & Bees Spiders Snakes Hypodermic Needles 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Uneven and Steep Ground (Slips, Trips, and Falls) Falling in River Broken Glass Brush (eye hazard) Boards with Nails Sharp Pieces of Metal (sheet metal, barbed wire, etc.) 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Containers with Unknown Contents (methyl-ethyl-death) Old Batteries (acid) give to truck diver Pressurized Spray Cans Household Chemicals (bleach, Drano, etc.) Drugs

Protective Gear to Consider

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Safety Glasses Boots or hard-soled shoes Gloves Sun Screen Bug Repellent 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Eye protection in areas of brush and sticks Some protection against stepping on sharp Footing in un-even and slick terrain Ankle support Leather or thick cotton gloves protect against splinters and cuts Nitrile or latex gloves protect against mud, slime, and chemicals. Protection against UV Better grade of tan Mosquitoes, ticks, and chiggers.
