ZONE CAPTAIN INFO

14th Annual Basura Bash, 2008

Your Responsibilities:

1. Act as a source of information for people in your zone.
2. Carry a mobile phone for communication with the command center at Mission County Park. Contact the Park in the event of an emergency, if you need more trash bags, or if you need assistance removing large objects at **(210) 534-8833**.
3. **Ensure that trash bags are taken to the Waste Management Collection Station. All trash bags must be transferred directly to the pickup truck or to the Waste Management Collection Station (described below). Recyclables are to be placed in blue bags.**
4. Ensure that each volunteer in your group is provided with a copy of the Safety Awareness sheet attached to the initial registration packet and that the volunteers follow safe practices such as wearing long pants, shirts, gloves and staying out of the water.

Zone Boundaries:

Upstream - Acequia

Downstream - Mission Espada

Parking and Access To Your Zone: Parking is available at the Camino Coahuilteca bridge on the west side of the River.

Your Waste Management Collection Station: Trash bags, metal, tires, and other objects will be picked up by Waste Management at Ashley Rd. The pickup truck will collect the trash bags along the park roads and transfer them to the Ashley Rd collection station. ****ALL TRASH BAGS MUST BE PLACED IN THE COLLECTION STATION AND TIGHTLY TIED****.

Pickup Support: A pickup will be driving along the Park roads picking up trash. Please make sure the filled trash bags and other objects are transferred to the Park roads. The pickup will have extra trash bags, drinking water, and a first aid kit.

The pickup driver will have radio communication with Mission County Park. If you need to contact your pickup driver, call the command center at 872-8859 on your mobile phone; the dispatcher will transfer your message to the driver.

Training Session/T-shirt Pickup: Please be prepared to arrive at Mission County Park with the signatures of your volunteers. At that time, you will be given the number of t-shirts you need and a quick training of the safety issues. You will take the t-shirts back to your zone where you will meet your group, pass out shirts, and go over the safety issues. **Arrive early enough to do all of this and meet your group at your zone before they start.**
